WHAT...

is the Regional Smoking Vehicle Program?

It is a public campaign for North Central Texans to anonymously report vehicles emitting visible smoke from the tailpipe, which is harmful to our health.

is considered a smoking vehicle?

A smoking vehicle, as defined by the State of Texas, emits visible smoke for 10 seconds or longer, or produces suspended smoke that does not fully dissipate within 10 seconds.

about diesel vehicles?

Yes, diesels are affected, too. The state law applies to all on-road vehicles regardless of fuel type.

happens after a vehicle is reported?

The vehicle owner receives a letter in the mail and is encouraged to have their vehicle inspected for emissions compliance. The letter also provides information on financial assistance that may be available to help repair or replace the vehicle.

report a smoking vehicle?

- ✓ TX license plate number
- ✓ City
- ✓ Cross streets
- ✓ Date & time observed

Common Diagnoses for Visible Smoke:

-  Incomplete fuel combustion
-  Engine oil being burned
-  Coolant in combustion chamber or incomplete air/fuel mixture
